OVERVIEW

We provide primary and secondary schools with a number of provision services such as, After School Clubs, Sports After School Clubs, Physical Education, Alternative Education and one on one Student Support as well as providing accredited training courses. We are based in South Gloucestershire and Bristol and our focus is to have a positive contribution on the young people that live within our local communities by providing them and their schools with the best service possible. During the 2016-17 delivery academic year we received zero complaints and had a staff attendance rate of a 100%, which resulted in us never cancelling a scheduled session. Why use us? ALTERNATIVE EDUCATION

Our qualified team of tutors/mentors provide one to one support and guidance for children and young people at our various placements. These placements are for those who struggle within mainstream education. Our staff are trained to aid individuals who are having a troubled home life, have low self-esteem, confidence, low mood, lack of motivation, and are reactive. Through our accredited programme and understanding approach we aim to aid children and young people to achieve their ambitions and aspirations, develop their problem solving skills, and communication strategies, to enable them to live a pro-social and positive lives in and out of an educational environments, as well as achieving accreditation.

SITES AND PLACEMENTS

Our South Gloucestershire Sport and Education Horticulture and Animal Centres enables young people to engage with animals and wildlife, whilst learning practical and theory skills about horticulture and animal care, as well as woodwork skills and basic construction knowledge. Whilst on site the learners will work towards and achieve accreditations, formalising and evidencing their learning.

Our South Gloucestershire Sport and Education Sports Centre is based at an amazing sports facility, complete with running track, hockey, football, rugby and cricket facilities. From here we run various provisions for those that have an interest in sport, and those that have other educational needs and interests.
